Topic (1 hour)	This work is repeated due to no work being handed in: Our topic is all about the Earth. This week you are going to be investigating into the water cycle. Please create a large poster with the key vocabulary that demonstrates how the water cycle works.

Art (30 Minutes)	Our class topic is Seaside. Looking at the work of Alfred Wallis, you are going to use the powerpoint to help you draw shells in colour. To draw these shells, use the style of Alfred Wallis and the colours he uses.
