### Other learning to be completed BY FRIDAY

Science (1 hour)	This week in Science, we are looking at how we keep our bodies healthy. We will be learning how diet and exercise helps our bodies and how they function. After following the presentation for this week, you are going to create an information text on the topic.
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<b>Topic (1 hour)</b>	Our topic is all about the Earth. This week you are going to investigate the different rivers found in the UK. You will need to find the following information and present your data: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Length of river.</li> <li>- Basin Size.</li> <li>- Source Location and its elevation.</li> <li>- The cities and counties it crosses.</li> <li>- Its discharge location.</li> </ul>
<b>Art (30 Minutes)</b>	Our class topic is Seaside. You are going to use the PowerPoint to help you make weaving seaside prints. The presentation on this gives some good examples. However, there is some complication with the tasks involved due to requiring a wire fence. Instead, I suggest using the examples to help you create your own weaving pattern. You can use any materials you like to create this and it can be of any scale.
<b>Mandarin (30 minutes)</b>	For Mandarin, please visit <a href="http://www.oxfordprimarymandarin.com">www.oxfordprimarymandarin.com</a> and follow the Year 5/6 activities. Please ensure you attend the sessions at 2:30pm on a Wednesday.
<b>Computing (30 minutes)</b>	We are going to be using Purple Mash and the 2caculate tool. You are going to use a spreadsheet to plan pocket money spending. You will use the same tools you have been using to create this spreadsheet and follow the step-by-step instructions given.
<b>PSHE (20 minutes)</b>	<b>REPEATED WEEK:</b> For the next two weeks, we are going to be looking at Curiosity. We are looking at answering the question 'Is it useful to be curious about your surroundings policy?' Read through this week's story and complete the Big Think journal.
