Note: How do you know when to use ou or ow?

When you hear /ow/ at the end of a word or syllable, use ow (cow, now, pow/er, show/er). When you hear /ow/ at the start of, or inside a word or syllable, use ou (ounce, house, loud). BUT: If the word rhymes with down (frown, clown, and town) or owl (howl, towel, and growl) we usually use ow.
