If you feel you need something a bit more challenging, look in the Year 2 Scheme of Learning (in the 'Resources' section) and work through the questions in both the 'Varied Fluency' and 'Reasoning and Problem Solving' sections. (Hide the answers to the RPS questions until you have had a go!) I will attach the worksheets that accompany the daily lesson videos.

Understand that an Island is an area of land that is completely surrounded by water.

Using the theme of shipwrecks as a stimulus, write a 'fantasy Island' poem inspired by a message in a bottle.
