Year 3 and 4		
Look at Oak Academy. Click on the pupil button – Then click on key stage 2 – English. Finally, click on the lesso		
for <b>"The Man on the Moon".</b>		
Work through a new lesson each day.		
You will need Some paper, pencil and ideas.		
Each day watch the video and then complete the lesson.		
Monday - Lesson 1 – To develop initial responses.		
Tuesday - Lesson 2 - To investigate suffixes – y		
Wednesday - Lesson 3 – To explore complex sentences		
Thursday - Lesson 4 – To describe 2 contrasting settings and characters.		
Friday - Lesson 5 – To develop an understanding of words associated with sadness.		
If you would like more work, then look at the English Grammar section – T1 sentence level objectives on the Oak academy site. You could do 1 lesson a day.		
This has a mix of term 1 objectives that are useful to be revisited.		
If you need confidence – then use BBC bitesize to back up the grammar expectations.		

#### Maths

Year 3 and 4	
Look at Oak Academy. Click on the pupil button – Then click on key stage 2 – Maths – Multiplication and	
division.	
Each day watch the video and then complete the lesson.	
Monday - Lesson 1 – Recalling 3 x table	
Tuesday - Lesson 2 – Recalling 4 x table	
Wednesday - Lesson 3 – Using arrays to represent the 3 and 4 x table	
Thursday - Lesson 4 – Understanding that multiplication can be completed in any order.	
Friday - Lesson 5 – Using the bar model to represent known times tables.	
If this work is proving difficult – Look at KS1- Maths – Multiplication and division. This will cover the same work at a simpler level.	
EXT – Look at the second section on Multiplication and division. This concentrated on multiplying 2 digits by 1 and teaches formats – This is suitable for confident children and year 4	
For extension – Deriving multiplication and division facts.

#### **TOPIC – The Rainforest**

- Task is to create a fact file on these Use any resources to help you.

You can either write a document or create a PowerPoint of the information.

#### **RE – Christianity**

You are going to look at how Christianity was founded and where it was founded Look at the PowerPoint.

Your task is to look at the images of Jesus and create your own.

#### Science – States of Matter

Look at your 2Do on Solid, Liquid and gases – Complete the sheet and then hand it in on Purple Mash. Try to be as detailed as you can on the sheet.

EXT – work out a different way of showing the difference between solids, liquids and gases. Could you make a short presentation? Could you make a model to show the difference? Try to be as interesting as possible.

#### Art – Kandinsky and Mondrian – Use online resources – 2 weeks' worth of planning

Look at picture by Kandinsky. What is his style? What do you like about his art?

Your task would be to create a picture in the style of Kandinsky.

Remember to look at the kind of shapes he uses and the colours.

OR

Look at pictures by Mondrian. What is his style? What do you like about his art? Mondrian has used his art when thinking about New York and maps. Could you create a picture in his style thinking about London?

Look at a map to help you.

**Computing** - To learn touch typing
