English

Year 3 and 4

Look at Oak Academy. Click on the pupil button – Then click on key stage 2 – English. Finally, click on the lessons for **“The Man on the Moon”**.

Work through a new lesson each day.

You will need Some paper, pencil and ideas.

Each day watch the video and then complete the lesson.

Monday - Lesson 11 – To write the second part of the build-up.

Tuesday - Lesson 12 – To plan the climax of the narrative.

Wednesday - Lesson 13 – To write the climax of the narrative.

Thursday - Lesson 14 – To edit the climax of the narrative.

Friday - Lesson 15 – To develop reading for pleasure through personal reflection.

If you would like more work, then look at the English Grammar section – T1 sentence level objectives on the Oak academy site. You could do 1 lesson a day.

This has a mix of term 1 objectives that are useful to be revisited.

If you need confidence – then use BBC bitesize to back up the grammar expectations.

Maths

Year 3 and 4

Look at Oak Academy. Click on the pupil button – Then click on key stage 2 – Maths – Multiplication and division.

Each day watch the video and then complete the lesson.

Monday - Lesson 11 – Solving correspondence problems.

Tuesday - Lesson 12 – Using doubles to multiply.

Wednesday - Lesson 13 – Using ten times greater for known times tables.

Thursday - Lesson 14 – Using bar models to represent word problems

Friday - Lesson 15 – To consolidate multiplication and division knowledge part 2.

If this work is proving difficult – Look at KS1- Maths – Multiplication and division. This will cover the same work at a simpler level.

EXT – Look at the second section on Multiplication and division. This concentrated on multiplying 2 digits by 1 and teaches formats – This is suitable for confident children and year 4

For extension – multiplication and division

Monday - Lesson 11 – Exploring multiplication strategies

Tuesday - Lesson 12 – Consolidating multiplication strategies

Wednesday - Lesson 13 – dividing mentally

Thursday - Lesson 14 – Dividing using knowledge of multiples

Friday - Lesson 15 – Short division – part 1.

Other work to be completed EVERY DAY

Reading (At least 20 minutes daily)	Read your book to yourself or practise reading aloud.
TOPIC – The Rainforest What animals live in the Rainforest? http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=LTiRw7kx97E - Sounds of the rainforest; http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-IAfg_ly7n8 - Sounds of the rainforest. These are links that show the sounds of the Rainforest and the animals that live there.	

<p>TASK – Create a power point, poster on Word or a handwritten poster to explain the different animals that live in the different layers of the Rainforest – look at the Power point to help. How interesting can you make your presentation? Remember to watch presentation if you are writing your poster. Include colours. Check you have copied spellings correctly.</p>
<p>RE – Christianity – 2 weeks’ worth of work You are going to look at Special places for Christianity Look at the power point and then try to create a short project, either on the computer or handwritten. You need to look at the different special places that Christians go to on Pilgrimage. Can you make a section in your project for each special place? Make sure that you watch your presentation and ensure you have used correct spellings.</p>
<p>Science – States of Matter – Changing states – 2 weeks’ worth of work First look at BBC bitesize - What are freezing and melting? - BBC Bitesize Watch the video and then complete the quiz. Then look at What is evaporation and condensation? - BBC Bitesize Watch the video and then complete the quiz. When you are happy with your understanding – Can you create a power point to explain the facts that you have found out? You need to explain clearly how materials can change state. If you need more direction – please send me an email.</p>
<p>Art – Henri Rousseau Look at pictures by Henri Rousseau online. He painted many pictures of the Rainforest. The most famous being “Surprised” What do you think about his art? What colours can you see? Does his art look realistic? Choose one of his Rainforest pictures and create your own version of the picture. Try to use a similar colour pallet as Rousseau would use. Be careful with your colouring – make sure that you are as neat as possible.</p>
