	<p>Look at Oak Academy. Click on the pupil button – Then click on key stage 2 – English. Finally, click on the lessons for “Monster Pizza Instructions”</p> <p>Work through a new lesson each day.</p> <p>You will need Some paper, pencil and ideas.</p> <p>Each day watch the video and then complete the lesson.</p> <p>Monday - Lesson 1 – To identify the features of instructions. Tuesday - Lesson 2 – To investigate suffixes -er and -est. Wednesday - Lesson 3 – To explore “being verbs”. Thursday - Lesson 4 – To devise ingredients for our Monster pizza. Friday - Lesson 5 – To develop a rich understanding of words associated with disgusting food.</p> <p>If you would like more work, then look at the English Grammar section – T2 sentence level objectives on the Oak academy site. You could do 1 lesson a day. This has a mix of term 1 objectives that are useful to be revisited.</p> <p>If you need confidence – then use BBC bitesize to back up the grammar expectations.</p>

Lesson 1 – recognising fractions as different representations.
Tuesday	Lesson 2 – To recognise parts that are equal and parts that are unequal.	Lesson 2 – Calculating unit fractions of quantities.
Wednesday	Lesson 3 – To recognise, identify and describe unit Fractions.	Lesson 3 – Recognising equivalent fractions.
Thursday	Lesson 4 – To find Fractions of a given quantity.	Lesson 4 – Recognising equivalent fractions (2)
Friday	Lesson 5 – To describe unit and non-unit Fractions.	Lesson 5 – Calculating non unit fractions of quantities.
	If you have difficulty with the Fractions and need to gain confidence – Simply go down a Year group until you feel confident. Year 3 can go to the Year 2 Maths section on Fractions – 10 lessons worth to help confidence.

Reading (At least 15 minutes daily)	Read your book to yourself or practise reading aloud.
