

Science (1 hour)	We are starting a new Science topic this term, which is Evolution and Inheritance. Our first lesson will focus on adaptation. You will be learning about adaptation and what the definition is of this word. You will then look at the adaptive traits that enable living things to survive in its habitat or environment.
