They need to focus on capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and reading their writing back to check it makes sense. If you need you can find some pictures on the internet to inspire their ideas.

Oy – toy, boy, joy. Oi- spoil, coin, join. Ir – twirl, bird, girl

After the zoom call, the children will be encouraged to write some of the green words we have looked at and to write a few sentences using a couple of chosen words. They need to focus on capital letters, finger spaces, full stops and reading their writing back to check it makes sense. If you need you can find some pictures on the internet to inspire their ideas.

Reading	Listen to your child read twice daily. It is important to read the same book lots of

	sound them out every time. Look out for the target sound of the week in all of the
	books you read. When looking at tricky words, frequently remind children, they are
	words that you cannot use your phonics to work out.

Play	Children learn best when they learn through play. Allow time for children to play
	freely indoors and outdoors without objectives every day. Incorporating what they
	have learnt that day in their play is an excellent way to see if they have grasped a
	concept or they might need some more support if they have any misconceptions.
