What have we been learning in school?

As part of their Art topic on Landscaping, children in Nightingales Class have been learning how to make a composition, experimenting with different media and materials to create texture. Children have made collages of the School and WSL Church linked to their Geography Topic on Local Area. They have to identify the key features of a landscape composition and consider where to put the horizon line. The children have used a range of materials to replicate the textures found in their local walk. They were also encouraged to use different tints, shades and hues to make the background. The children have enjoyed learning and applying the acquired knowledge and different skills.

Each class has now voted the three best acts to perform in the whole school 'WSL Got Talent' Show this afternoon.
