## What have we been learning in school?

**Bikeability Training** - Children in Year 4 have thoroughly enjoyed their Bikeability Cycle Training at Level 1 this week. They all followed instructions carefully and practised some basic skills and learned more about how to ride their bikes safely by keeping some distance. They have become more confident and are reminded to remember to keep their fingers on the brakes and the instructors were very impressed with the children's energy and enthusiasm and how attentive, polite and sensible all children are! Well done, children, keep practising! Thank you for giving permission for the children to come on the course.



PEEACE- Next week we will focus on the related value of **Growth**. The children in their classes will discuss and reflect on "Can you flow through your changing emotions? Are you able to go with the flow?" Perhaps you can have further discussions with your child/ren at home and ask your child/ren – 'How do you feel when you are stuck with an uncomfortable feeling? How do you feel when your emotions start flowing again? You may also want to explore the meaning of this quote *'Let's not forget that the little emotions are the great captains of our lives and we obey them without realizing it.'* Vincent van Gogh, Dutch painter (1853 – 1890).
