Dear Parents/Carers,

Once again, the **Open Morning** on Monday and Wednesday this week went really well. We had many prospective parents coming to see the school in action. A huge 'Thank you' goes to our Year 6 children Hector and Robyn who shared their thoughts about why WSL is a great school, what they like about our school and how they are supported and challenged in lessons etc. They skilfully conveyed distinctive qualities that make our school such a nurturing and





inspiring place for learning. They welcomed questions from prospective parents and provided thoughtful and insightful responses that showcased their profound understanding of our School Values. We are immensely proud of Hector and Robyn for their outstanding presentation. Our visitors were very impressed and have given some very positive feedback.

I cannot believe that it is December! This term has flown by. There is, however, still so much to do before we break up for Christmas. With Christmas fast approaching, the corridors are filled with children's beautiful singing in preparation for our Christmas performances: Nativity and Christingles. Throughout the week I have heard snippets of the rehearsal for our **KS1 Nativity Play** which we are all looking forward to watching next week. All parents in KS1 are warmly invited to join us. Please make sure you have booked your seats via sQuid if you have not done so. Two performances for parents next week are on **Wednesday** 6th **December at 2.00pm** and also on **Friday 8th December at 2.00pm** followed by Tea and Coffee in the Dining Hall and PTA Raffle tickets being sold on Friday only. Thank you to the teachers and TAs who are all working very hard to help the children get ready for their performances.

What have we been learning in school?

In **Mandarin** this week, the children in **Robins Class** were recapping 10s numbers to 100, and learning to say all 2-digit numbers. They had lots of competitions and played games to help with their learning.

Over the past two weeks, some of the Robins have been studying a book called 'Beegu', by Alexis Deacon. Last week, they thought about the feelings of the main character, Beegu, and worked in pairs to put feeling words where they felt they belonged on a Zone of Relevance. This week, in groups, they made a freeze frame of the part of the book they have read up to. They then had to say what they thought their character was thinking, if a thought bubble was held over them. After this, they decided what they thought would happen next in the story, and acted it out for the rest of the children.



The children continue to enjoy a variety of extracurricular activities we offer after school. Since Term 2 the children in LEGO Club have been working on the theme: **Pole to Pole!** Children have had fun building some exciting models from **Penguins** to **Polar Bears!** Here are some photos of what they have created Penguins, an Antarctic Explorer, an Igloo and Polar Bears.





Next week we will focus on the value of **Freedom**. Children will be exploring what 'Freedom' means and consider questions as age appropriate, such as 'Do you know when to act freely and when to act safely? Or Can you find the balance between acting freely and acting safely?' Perhaps you can have a discussion at home and spend some time with your child exploring the meaning of the quote: "Freedom is not worth having if it does not include the freedom to make mistakes.' — Mahatma Gandhi, a non-violent spiritual and political leader (1869-1948). What might this quote mean?
